**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 1061**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the semicolon insert “creating  
2 new provisions; amending ORS 475C.939;”.

3 On page 2, after line 9, insert:

4 **“SECTION 2.** ORS 475C.939 is amended to read:

5 “475C.939. (1) In addition to any other duty prescribed by law, the Oregon  
6 Cannabis Commission shall:

7 “[1] (a) Provide advice to the Oregon Health Authority with respect to  
8 the administration of ORS 475C.770 to 475C.919;

9 “[2] (b) Provide advice to the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission  
10 with respect to the administration of ORS 475C.005 to 475C.525, insofar as  
11 those statutes pertain to registry identification cardholders and designated  
12 primary caregivers, as those terms are defined in ORS 475C.777;

13 “[3] (c) Develop a long-term strategic plan for ensuring that cannabis  
14 will remain a therapeutic option for persons with debilitating medical con-  
15 ditions as defined in ORS 475C.777;

16 “[4] (d) Develop a long-term strategic plan for ensuring that cannabis  
17 will remain affordable for persons with debilitating medical conditions as  
18 defined in ORS 475C.777; *[and]*

19 “[5] (e) Monitor and study federal laws, regulations and policies re-  
20 garding marijuana[.]; **and**

21 **“(f)(A) Determine the optimal framework for the continued**

1 governance of the program administered under ORS 475C.770 to  
2 475C.919 and steps that the state must take, whether administrative  
3 or legislative in nature, to ensure that research on cannabis and  
4 cannabis-derived products is being conducted for public purposes; and

5 “(B) Once every two years, submit a report in the manner provided  
6 in ORS 192.245 to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly  
7 related to health care and the judiciary on the status of the program  
8 administered under ORS 475C.770 to 475C.919 and the progress the  
9 Oregon Cannabis Commission has made, since the immediately pre-  
10 ceding report submitted as described in this paragraph, in carrying out  
11 the commission’s duties described in this section and as otherwise  
12 determined by the commission. As part of the report described in this  
13 paragraph, the commission may make recommendations for legis-  
14 lation.

15 “(2) As necessary to carry out the duties described in subsection (1)  
16 of this section, the Oregon Cannabis Commission may collaborate and  
17 consult with the chairpersons of the committees and interim commit-  
18 tees of the Legislative Assembly related to health care and the judici-  
19 ary.

20 “SECTION 3. The Oregon Cannabis Commission shall first report  
21 as described in the amendments to ORS 475C.939 by section 2 of this  
22 2023 Act not later than September 15, 2024.”.

23 In line 10, delete “2” and insert “4”.

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
