PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2979

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, after line 4, insert:

"(4) The department may retain, from any disbursement made to the department for the purposes of carrying out the provisions of this section, an amount necessary to cover costs incurred by the department in administering the grant program described in this section. Administration costs may include, but are not limited to, any outreach conducted by the department and personnel necessary to administer the grant program.".

8 In line 5, delete "(4)" and insert "(5)".

9 Delete lines 12 through 19 and insert:

"<u>SECTION 5.</u> (1) As used in this section, 'dental professional' in cludes dentists, dental hygienists, dental assistants, dental therapists
 and dental health aides.

"(2) The Oregon Health Authority shall, through the health care 13 provider incentive program created under ORS 676.454 and in consul-14 tation with the Office of Rural Health, issue grants to support and 15increase the recruitment and retention of dental professionals in all 16 regions of this state. The authority may issue grants to dental pro-17 fessionals, and to federally qualified health centers and other employ-18 ers of dental professionals, that provide dental care in underserved 19 areas of this state. 20

21 "(3) In issuing grants under this section, the authority shall prior-

itize recruitment and retention of dental professionals in rural areas,
 low-income communities and tribal communities.".

3 Delete lines 24 through 32 and insert:

4 "<u>SECTION 7.</u> (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall develop and
5 implement an education and mentoring program to promote the entry
6 into dental professions by members of federally recognized Indian
7 tribes in Oregon.

8 "(2) The authority may carry out its duty under this section by 9 entering into an agreement with a federally recognized Indian tribe in 10 this state or a tribal organization, as defined in the Indian Self-11 Determination and Education Assistance Act of 1975 (P.L. 93-638), in 12 this state to develop and implement the program described in sub-13 section (1) of this section.".

14 Delete lines 37 through 45 and delete <u>page 3</u> and insert:

"SECTION 9. (1) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission 15shall develop and maintain a website to provide information about 16 dental assistant training and certification, including information 17 about eligibility requirements and other requirements of the Oregon 18 Board of Dentistry, required core education competencies and a list 19 of existing resources for dental assistant training programs and edu-20cation modules. The website must be available free of cost to all den-21tists licensed to practice in this state. 22

"(2) The commission shall convene, and facilitate discussion among, relevant stakeholders in developing and maintaining the website described in subsection (1) of this section. The stakeholders may include, but are not limited to, representatives of dental assistant education programs at community colleges in this state and dental professional associations.

"(3) The commission, in consultation with the stakeholders de scribed in subsection (2) of this section:

"(a) Shall provide financial assistance to individuals seeking access
 to existing online dental assistant training materials and resources;
 and

4 "(b) May develop additional dental assistant training materials as
5 the commission determines necessary.

6 "(4) The commission may adopt rules to carry out this section.

"SECTION 10. There is appropriated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of
the General Fund, the amount of \$2,000,000 for the purpose of carrying
out the provisions of section 9 of this 2023 Act.".
