**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2835**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after “fishing” insert “; and prescribing an
2 effective date”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 27 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) The State Department of Fish and Wildlife, in**
5 **consultation with the Oregon Conservation and Recreation Advisory**
6 **Committee, shall award grants for the establishment or improvement**
7 **of public facilities for recreational fishing located inside an urban**
8 **growth boundary. Projects for which grants are awarded must serve**
9 **to protect, maintain or enhance fish and wildlife resources in Oregon,**
10 **as described in ORS 496.252 (2).**

11 **“(2) Grants awarded under this section shall be paid out of the**
12 **Oregon Conservation and Recreation Fund established under ORS**
13 **496.252.**

14 **“(3) In carrying out this section, the department shall consider op-**
15 **portunities to coordinate with the Restoration and Enhancement**
16 **Board established under ORS 496.286 to enhance fishing access.**

17 **“SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
18 **ation, there is appropriated to the State Department of Fish and**
19 **Wildlife, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General**
20 **Fund, the amount of \$200,000, for deposit in the Oregon Conservation**
21 **and Recreation Fund established under ORS 496.252 for the purpose of**

1 **awarding grants under section 1 of this 2023 Act.**

2 **“SECTION 3. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2,**
3 **2026.**

4 **“SECTION 4. This 2023 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the**
5 **date on which the 2023 regular session of the Eighty-second Legislative**
6 **Assembly adjourns sine die.”**
