**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2506**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “housing;” delete the rest of
2 the line and insert “creating new provisions; and amending ORS 197.660,
3 197.665, 197.667 and 197.670.”.

4 On page 2, delete lines 14 through 39 and insert:

5 “**NOTE:** Section 2 was deleted by amendment. Subsequent sections were
6 not renumbered.”.

7 On page 3, after line 35, insert:

8 “**SECTION 6.** Section 7 of this 2023 Act is added to and made a part
9 of ORS 197.660 to 197.670.

10 “**SECTION 7.** (1) As used in this section, ‘children’s safety zone’
11 means any place within the jurisdiction of a local government within
12 1,000 feet of:

13 “(a) A public elementary or secondary school for which attendance
14 is compulsory under ORS 339.020;

15 “(b) A private or parochial elementary or secondary school, teach-
16 ing children as described in ORS 339.030 (1)(a); or

17 “(c) A child care facility as defined in ORS 329A.250 (5).

18 “(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of ORS 197.660 to 197.670,
19 a local government may enact an ordinance:

20 “(a) Prohibiting a residential facility or residential home located
21 within a children’s safety zone from employing or accepting as an

1 **employee or resident:**

2 **“(A) A person required to report as a sex offender under ORS**
3 **163A.010, 163A.015, 163A.020 or 163A.025; or**

4 **“(B) An individual convicted of a person felony, as that term is**
5 **defined in the rules of the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission; or**

6 **“(b) Requiring a residential facility or residential home located**
7 **within a children’s safety zone to provide adequate staff present on the**
8 **premises at all times if a resident of the facility or home meets the**
9 **criteria set forth in paragraph (a) of this subsection.”.**

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
