PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2472

1 On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 24 and delete <u>page</u> 2 2 and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) A public university listed in ORS 352.002 may par ticipate in interscholastic activities, including but not limited to
 interscholastic sporting events, only if the public university:

6 "(a) Implements equity-focused policies that address the use of 7 language, insults, verbal assaults, profanity, ridicule or the display of 8 gestures, signs, symbols or images that:

"(A) Are physically threatening, abusive or discriminatory, including on the basis of race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, gender,
gender identity, disability or sexual orientation; and

"(B) Occur at an interscholastic activity, including by spectators
 of the interscholastic activity;

14 "(b) Maintains a transparent complaint process that:

"(A) Has a reporting system to allow participants of interscholastic
 activities or members of the public to make complaints about student,
 coach or spectator behavior;

"(B) Responds to a complaint made under subparagraph (A) of this
 paragraph within two business days of the complaint being received;
 and

21 "(C) Strives to resolve a complaint received under subparagraph (A)

1 of this paragraph within 30 days of the complaint being received;

"(c) Develops and implements sanctions against students, coaches
and spectators if a complaint made under paragraph (b) of this subsection is verified; and

"(d) Performs an annual survey of student athletes and student
spectators to understand and respond to potential violations of
equity-focused policies adopted under paragraph (a) of this subsection
or violations of ORS 659.850.

9 "(2) Sanctions that are developed and implemented under sub-10 section (1)(c) of this section shall include a prohibition from attending 11 future interscholastic activities for a defined period of time, with more 12 severe infractions resulting in longer periods of exclusion from future 13 interscholastic activities.

14 "(3) Each employee of a public university whose official duties re-15 late to the management, oversight or running of athletic events at the 16 public university must receive formal training regarding the require-17 ments established by this section.

18 **"(4) As used in this section:**

"(a) 'Interscholastic activities' means any activity between a public
 university listed in ORS 352.002 and one or more other universities or
 colleges that is outside of the regular academic curriculum of the
 public university.

"(b) 'Interscholastic activities' does not include any intramural or
 recreational sporting events that are not organized by the National
 Collegiate Athletic Association or other established athletic confer ence.

"<u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) Each public university listed in ORS 352.002 shall
submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, to the interim
committees of the Legislative Assembly related to higher education
no later than September 15 of each calendar year.

1 "(2) The report required under subsection (1) of this section shall 2 include, for the previous academic year:

"(a) The number of complaints reported under the process described
in section 1 (1)(b) of this 2023 Act;

"(b) The number, level and type of sanctions applied by the public
university in response to complaints described in paragraph (a) of this
subsection;

8 "(c) A summary of the implementation of the complaint process
9 described in section 1 (1)(b) of this 2023 Act;

"(d) The results of the student athlete and student spectator survey
 completed pursuant to section 1 (1)(d) of this 2023 Act;

"(e) An overview of the training for individuals whose official duties
relate to the management, oversight or running of athletic events as
required under section 1 (3) of this 2023 Act; and

"(f) Any additional efforts by the public university related to the
 provision of student and spectator safety at interscholastic activities.

"(3) As used in this section, 'interscholastic activities' has the
 meaning given that term in section 1 of this 2023 Act.

"<u>SECTION 3.</u> (1) Section 1 of this 2023 Act first applies to the
 2023-2024 academic year.

"(2) The first report required under section 2 of this 2023 Act must
be submitted no later than September 15, 2024.

"<u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
 declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect on its passage.".
