"(3) If a member of the pension program has 25 years or more of retire-15ment credit as a telecommunicator, as defined in ORS 181A.355, earliest re-16 tirement age for the member is 55 years of age or the age of the member 17 when the member acquires a total of 25 years or more of retirement credit 18 as a telecommunicator, whichever occurs first. A member who retires under 19 this subsection before attaining the age of 55 shall not receive a cost-of-20living adjustment under ORS 238A.210 until the member attains the age of 2155. 22

"(4) A member of the pension program who has reached earliest retirement age may retire on an early retirement date that is the first day of any month on or after the member has reached earliest retirement age.".
