**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 962**

1 Delete lines 11 through 14 of the printed bill and insert:

2 “(a) The county is one of Clatsop, Coos, Curry, Douglas, Lane, Lincoln
3 or Tillamook counties; and

4 “(b) The emergency management agency of the county is funded by federal
5 moneys distributed through the Emergency Management Performance Grant
6 administered by the Federal Emergency Management Agency.”.

7 After line 26, insert:

8 **“SECTION 3. (1) The Emergency Preparedness Advisory Council**
9 **established under section 151, chapter 539, Oregon Laws 2021, shall**
10 **convene a Committee on County Emergency Management.**

11 **“(2) The committee must consist of not more than half of the**
12 **members of the council. The council shall appoint a chairperson and**
13 **vice chairperson for the committee.**

14 **“(3) The committee shall study and make recommendations re-**
15 **garding the capacity of counties in Oregon to prepare for, respond to**
16 **and recover from emergencies. The recommendations must include**
17 **recommendations for methods to establish dedicated funding for**
18 **county emergency management staff, including at least a director and**
19 **deputy director of emergency management in each county.**

20 **“(4) On or before December 31, 2024, the committee shall transmit**
21 **a report describing its findings and recommendations to the interim**

1 committees of the Legislative Assembly relating to emergency man-
2 agement.

3 “(5) The Legislative Revenue Officer is directed to assist the Com-
4 mittee on County Emergency Management in carrying out revenue
5 projections and any other tasks the committee deems necessary for
6 the performance of its duties.

7 “SECTION 4. Section 3 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2,
8 2026.”.
