**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2345**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after “custody” insert “; and prescribing an
2 effective date”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 9 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Corrections shall undertake**
5 **reasonable efforts to reduce the number of days an adult in custody**
6 **may be in segregated housing at a department correctional facility.**

7 **“(2) The department shall establish a committee to study the im-**
8 **plementation of subsection (1) of this section and develop recommen-**
9 **dations outlining the staffing, program and facility needs required to**
10 **comply with section 2 of this 2023 Act.**

11 **“(3) The committee must consist of at least:**

12 **“(a) One individual who is currently an adult in custody.**

13 **“(b) One individual who was formerly an adult in custody.**

14 **“(c) One representative from each of the major unions representing**
15 **department staff.**

16 **“(4) No later than September 1 of each year, the department shall**
17 **provide updated results of the study described in subsection (2) of this**
18 **section, along with any recommended legislative changes, in a report**
19 **to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the**
20 **judiciary in the manner provided under ORS 192.245.**

21 **“SECTION 2. An adult in custody may not be subject to segregated**

1 housing at a department correctional facility for more than 14 con-
2 secutive days.

3 **“SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2023 Act becomes operative on July**
4 **1, 2027.**

5 **“SECTION 4. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2,**
6 **2028.**

7 **“SECTION 5. This 2023 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the**
8 **date on which the 2023 regular session of the Eighty-second Legislative**
9 **Assembly adjourns sine die.”.**

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
