PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3349

1 On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, line 2, delete "creating new provisions; 2 amending ORS 284.754;".

3 Delete lines 5 through 28.

4 Delete pages 2 through 9 and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1)(a) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission, in consultation with the Oregon Department of Administrative
Services, shall enter into an agreement with Oregon Solutions at
Portland State University to:

"(A) Assess interest in and convene, as appropriate, entities to
 collaboratively develop an infrastructure funding readiness hub, as
 described in subsection (2) of this section; and

"(B) Enter into agreements with the entities described in subsection
(4) of this section to perform the functions of funding navigators, as
provided in subsection (3) of this section.

"(b) The agreement entered into under paragraph (a)(A) of this
 subsection shall provide for the amount of \$300,000 to be paid to
 Oregon Solutions to facilitate the collaborative development of the
 infrastructure funding readiness hub.

19 "(2)(a) The purpose of the infrastructure funding readiness hub is 20 to improve, for communities in this state, awareness of and access to 21 state and federal funding opportunities related to natural or built infrastructure, including the ability to manage and successfully expend funds. The infrastructure funding readiness hub shall place particular emphasis on capacities to access and secure near-term federal
funding opportunities. The infrastructure funding readiness hub shall
include, but need not be limited to, the following components:

6 "(A) An inventory of funding opportunities related to natural or
7 built infrastructure;

8 "(B) Systems or processes to track state matching fund needs;

9 "(C) Mechanisms for ongoing statewide coordination to increase 10 funding readiness, with particular emphasis on opportunities to in-11 crease federal funding readiness;

"(D) Recommendations to better align state and federal funding
 opportunities;

14 "(E) Identification of the needs of environmental justice communi-15 ties, as defined in ORS 182.535, communities that have experienced 16 historic lack of investment, communities that have infrastructure in 17 need of critical upgrades and communities that have limited 18 infrastructure, and opportunities to increase the federal funding 19 readiness of those communities; and

20 "(F) Mechanisms to track the benefits and outcomes of a coordi-21 nated approach to infrastructure funding readiness.

"(b) In developing the infrastructure funding readiness hub, Oregon 22Solutions at Portland State University shall coordinate with the office 23of the Governor, the Regional Solutions Program established under 24ORS 284.754, the entities described in subsection (4) of this section, 25state agencies with programs related to infrastructure funding and 26other relevant entities. Oregon Solutions at Portland State University 27may award grants or stipends to entities that participate in the 28collaborative development of the infrastructure funding readiness hub. 29 "(c) Oregon Solutions at Portland State University, in coordination 30

with the entities described in subsection (4) of this section, shall submit a report on the development of the infrastructure funding readiness hub, in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, to the appropriate
interim committees of the Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2024.

6 "(3) Working in coordination with the infrastructure funding read-7 iness hub, funding navigators shall perform, or enter into contracts 8 to have performed, functions in their respective areas of expertise that 9 include but are not limited to:

"(a) Increasing access to information, resources and assistance for
 navigating available funding opportunities related to natural or built
 infrastructure, with a focus on near-term federal funding opportu nities;

"(b) Developing an inventory of state matching funds needed to se cure federal funding for natural or built infrastructure;

"(c) Identifying barriers to accessing state and federal funding op portunities, or securing state or local matching funds, for natural or
 built infrastructure and providing recommendations to address barri ers; and

"(d) Assessing and supporting capacity at the community level to
 secure and expend infrastructure funding.

"(4)(a) Oregon Solutions at Portland State University shall enter
 into agreements with the following entities to perform the functions
 of a funding navigator:

25 "(A) The League of Oregon Cities, to perform the functions of a 26 funding navigator as they relate to cities.

"(B) The Association of Oregon Counties, to perform the functions
of a funding navigator as they relate to counties.

"(C) The Special Districts Association of Oregon, to perform the
 functions of a funding navigator as they relate to special districts.

1 "(D) The Oregon Economic Development Districts Association, to 2 perform the functions of a funding navigator as they relate to eco-3 nomic development districts and partner organizations.

4 "(E) The Oregon Conservation Partnership, to perform the func5 tions of a funding navigator as they relate to conservation groups.

"(F) The Affiliated Tribes of Northwest Indians Economic Development Corporation, to perform the functions of a funding navigator as
they relate to tribal governments.

9 "(G) The Oregon Community Foundation, to perform the functions
10 of a funding navigator as they relate to community-based organiza11 tions.

"(b) The agreements entered into under this subsection shall provide for the amount of \$300,000 to be paid to each of the entities described in paragraph (a)(A) to (G) of this subsection to perform the functions of a funding navigator.

16 "SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-17 ation, there is appropriated to the Higher Education Coordinating 18 Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the Gen-19 eral Fund, the amount of \$2,400,000, which may be expended for en-10 tering into the agreement with Oregon Solutions at Portland State 20 University described in section 1 of this 2023 Act.

"<u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect on its passage.".

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
