**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 279**

1 On page 2 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 10, delete “uni-”.

2 In line 11, delete “formed service” and insert “Armed Forces”.

3 In line 32, delete “uniformed service” and insert “Armed Forces”.

4 In line 33, delete “on active duty”.

5 On page 6, line 8, after “states” insert “, except that, notwithstanding any  
6 term to the contrary in this Compact, such rules shall be binding on the  
7 State of Oregon only to the extent they are adopted as rules by the state’s  
8 licensing authority”.

9 On page 9, line 15, after “ment” insert “, except that, notwithstanding any  
10 term to the contrary in this Compact, such rules and amendments shall be  
11 binding on the State of Oregon only to the extent they are adopted as rules  
12 by the state’s licensing authority”.

13 On page 11, line 24, delete “both”.

14 In line 25, delete “and damages”.

15 On page 12, after line 43, insert:

16 “D. Notwithstanding any term to the contrary in this Compact:

17 “1. No term of this Compact may be construed to require the State of  
18 Oregon to make any payment to the commission or to any other person, en-  
19 tity, or public body, whether domiciled in the State of Oregon or in any other  
20 state, territory, or foreign country, other than pursuant to the laws of the  
21 State of Oregon regarding the appropriation and expenditure of the funds of

1 the State of Oregon; and

2 “2. The State of Oregon’s payment of any amounts due under this Com-  
3 pact to the commission, including any assessments or fees imposed under  
4 Article VII.D.7.c, or to any other person, entity, or public body, whether  
5 domiciled in the State of Oregon or any other state, territory, or foreign  
6 country, is conditioned on and subject to the State of Oregon’s receiving  
7 appropriations, limitations, allotments or other expenditure authority to al-  
8 low the State of Oregon, in the exercise of its reasonable administrative  
9 discretion, to make such payment.”.
