**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2756**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “amending ORS 366.483” and
2 insert “creating new provisions; amending ORS 366.483; and declaring an
3 emergency”.

4 Delete lines 4 through 32 and delete page 2 and insert:

5 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 366.483 is amended to read:

6 “366.483. (1) In accordance with ORS 374.329, the Department of Trans-
7 portation shall transfer jurisdiction of the following state highways to the
8 following cities:

9 “(a) Pacific Highway West, State Highway 99, from the department to the
10 City of Eugene. The department shall transfer the following two portions:

11 “(A) The portion beginning where the highway intersects with the
12 Beltline Highway and ending where the highway intersects with Washington
13 Street, but excluding the bridge at milepost 121.42.

14 “(B) The portion beginning where the highway intersects with Walnut
15 Street and ending where the highway intersects with Interstate 5, but ex-
16 cluding the bridge at milepost 126.02.

17 “(b) Springfield Highway, State Highway 228 to the City of Springfield.

18 “(2) Notwithstanding section 71d (4), chapter 750, Oregon Laws 2017, the
19 department shall use the funds described in section 71d, chapter 750, Oregon
20 Laws 2017, for the transfer of Powell Boulevard to upgrade the portion of
21 Southeast Powell Boulevard beginning where the highway intersects with

1 Interstate 205 and ending where the highway intersects with the city limits.
2 After the upgrades are completed, in accordance with ORS 374.329, the de-
3 partment shall transfer jurisdiction of the upgraded portion to the City of
4 Portland. The department may upgrade and transfer portions of the highway
5 in phases.

6 **“(3) The department shall upgrade the portion of Hall Boulevard**
7 **that is located within the city limits of the City of Tigard to a state**
8 **of good repair, including multimodal enhancements. After the up-**
9 **grades are completed, in accordance with ORS 374.329, the department**
10 **shall transfer jurisdiction of the upgraded portion to the City of**
11 **Tigard.**

12 “[3] (4) In accordance with ORS 366.290:

13 “(a) The department shall transfer jurisdiction of the portion of Territo-
14 rial Highway, State Highway 200, that is located within Lane County from
15 the department to the county. The department may transfer portions of the
16 highway in phases. The department shall retain jurisdiction of bridges on
17 Territorial Highway located at milepoints 4.59, 7.07, 17.92, 18.72, 18.98, 19.28
18 and 25.49. The department shall transfer the jurisdiction of the bridges after
19 the bridges are replaced.

20 “(b) The department shall transfer jurisdiction of the portion of the
21 Springfield-Creswell Highway, State Highway 222, beginning where it inter-
22 sects with Jasper-Lowell Road and ending where it intersects with Emerald
23 Parkway to Lane County. The department shall retain jurisdiction of bridges
24 on Springfield-Creswell Highway located at mileposts 5.20, 5.41, 5.64 and
25 13.36. The department shall transfer the jurisdiction of a bridge after the
26 bridge is replaced.

27 “(c) Lane County shall transfer jurisdiction of the portion of Delta
28 Highway beginning where the highway intersects with Interstate 105 and
29 ending where the highway intersects with the Randy Pape Beltline from the
30 county to the department.

1 “(d) Multnomah County and Washington County shall transfer jurisdic-
2 tion of the portion of Cornelius Pass Road beginning where the highway
3 intersects with U.S. Highway 30 and ending where the highway intersects
4 with U.S. Highway 26 from the counties to the department. The counties may
5 transfer portions of the highway in phases.

6 **“SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
7 ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Transportation, for
8 the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the
9 amount of \$50,000,000 for costs related to upgrading the portion of Hall
10 Boulevard that is located within the city limits of the City of Tigard
11 to a state of good repair, including multimodal enhancements, and
12 transferring that portion to the City of Tigard.**

13 **“SECTION 3. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate
14 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
15 declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect July 1, 2023.”.**
