**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 789**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 21, delete “license” and insert  
2 “permit”.

3 Delete lines 23 through 29 and insert:

4 “(a) Authorize a person to grow canola within the Willamette Valley  
5 Protected District only if the person maintains isolation distances between  
6 the canola and other Brassica species that are determined by the department  
7 based on seed certification isolation distance standards established by  
8 Oregon State University.

9 “(b) Authorize canola production within the Willamette Valley Protected  
10 District, not to exceed:

11 “(A) Five thousand acres in 2023, 2024 or 2025.

12 “(B) Ten thousand acres in 2026, 2027 or 2028.

13 “(C) Fifteen thousand acres in 2029, 2030, 2031 or 2032.”.

14 In line 31, delete “license” and insert “permit”.

15 On page 2, after line 7, insert:

16 **“SECTION 3. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on July 1,  
17 2032.”.**

18 In line 8, delete “3” and insert “4”.
