5 **the following amounts, for the following purposes:**

18 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**
19 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the**
20 **Oregon Youth Authority, for the following purposes:**

1 (2) Community programs \$ 2,570,757

2 (3) Program support..... \$ 5,542,557

3 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
4 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**
5 **1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal**
6 **funds collected or received by the Oregon Youth Authority, for the**
7 **following purposes:**

8 (1) Community programs \$ 35,983,223

9 (2) Program support..... \$ 2,035,953

10 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
11 **the amount of \$4,259,816 is established for the biennium beginning July**
12 **1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Oregon**
13 **Youth Authority from American Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus State**
14 **Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys received by the Oregon Department of**
15 **Administrative Services and transferred to the Oregon Youth Author-**
16 **ity, for capital improvements and the Juvenile Justice Information**
17 **System upgrade project.**

18 **“SECTION 5. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate**
19 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
20 **declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect July 1, 2023.”.**
