**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 1090**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “creating new provisions;”.

2 Delete lines 6 through 26 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 2.** ORS 187.110 is amended to read:

4 “187.110. (1) The standard of time for the State of Oregon shall be the
5 United States standard of time as established by the Congress of the United
6 States for any particular area of the state under 15 U.S.C. 261[, *except that*
7 *from 2 a.m. on the second Sunday in March until 2 a.m. on the first Sunday*
8 *in November the standard of time for any area of this state shall be one hour*
9 *in advance of the standard established for that particular area by the Congress*
10 *of the United States under 15 U.S.C. 261*].

11 **“(2) The State of Oregon, including all political subdivisions of the**
12 **State of Oregon, is exempt from 15 U.S.C. 260a, pursuant to the au-**
13 **thority set forth in 15 U.S.C. 260a (a)(2).**

14 “[~~(2)~~] (3) No department of the state government and no county, city or
15 other political subdivision shall employ any other time or adopt any statute,
16 ordinance or order providing for the use of any other standard of time.

17 **“SECTION 3.** ORS 187.110, as amended by section 1, chapter 421, Oregon
18 Laws 2019, is amended to read:

19 “187.110. (1) The standard of time for the State of Oregon shall be [*one*
20 *hour in advance of*] the United States standard of time as established by the
21 Congress of the United States for any particular area of the state under 15

1 U.S.C. 261[, *except that*:]

2 “[*a*) *The standard of time for that portion of the State of Oregon that is*
3 *in the Mountain Time Zone shall be the United States standard of time as*
4 *established by the Congress of the United States for that area under 15 U.S.C.*
5 *261; and*]

6 “[*b*) *From 2 a.m. on the second Sunday in March until 2 a.m. on the first*
7 *Sunday in November the standard of time for that portion of the State of*
8 *Oregon that is in the Mountain Time Zone shall be one hour in advance of the*
9 *standard established for that area by the Congress of the United States under*
10 *15 U.S.C. 261.*]

11 **“(2) The State of Oregon, including all political subdivisions of the**
12 **State of Oregon, is exempt from 15 U.S.C. 260a, pursuant to the au-**
13 **thority set forth in 15 U.S.C. 260a (a)(2).**
