"(2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the 27amount of \$15,708,570 is established for the biennium beginning July 281, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Oregon 29 Department of Administrative Services from American Rescue Plan 30

Act Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys received by the
 Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the office of the
 State Chief Information Officer.

4 "<u>SECTION 6.</u> For the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, the following
5 expenditures by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services are
6 not limited:

"(1) Expenditures from the Insurance Fund for acquiring and purchasing insurance or reinsurance, allocating and collecting premiums
and paying claims for coverage pursuant to statutory authority.

"(2) Expenditures from the Mass Transit Assistance Account for
 payments described in ORS 291.407 to mass transit districts, transpor tation districts and service districts.

"SECTION 7. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
 declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect July 1, 2023.".
