**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 619**

1 On page 3 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 41, delete “gender
2 identity,”.

3 On page 4, line 20, after “corporation” insert “, including the Oregon
4 Health and Science University and the Oregon State Bar,”.

5 In line 31, after “corporation” insert “, including the Oregon Health and
6 Science University and the Oregon State Bar,”.

7 On page 6, line 3, after “706.008” insert “, or a financial institution’s af-
8 filiate or subsidiary that is only and directly engaged in financial activities,
9 as described in 12 U.S.C. 1843(k), as in effect on the effective date of this
10 2023 Act”.

11 Delete lines 4 and 5 and insert:

12 “(m) Information that originates from, or is intermingled so as to be in-
13 distinguishable from, information described in paragraph (k)(A) of this sub-
14 section and that a licensee, as defined in ORS 725.010, collects, processes,
15 uses or maintains in the same manner as is required under the laws and
16 regulations specified in paragraph (k)(A) of this subsection;”.

17 On page 9, line 40, delete “and” and insert “or”.

18 On page 12, line 5, delete “controller” and insert “processor”.

19 On page 20, after line 44, insert:

20 **“SECTION 14. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
21 the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (3), chapter**

1 _____, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5514), for the
2 biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment
3 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscella-
4 neous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, col-
5 lected or received by the Department of Justice for the Civil
6 Enforcement Division, is increased by \$1,780,729 for the purpose of
7 carrying out the provisions of this 2023 Act.”.

8 In line 45, delete “14” and insert “15”.
