**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 5002**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 27 and delete page  
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the State Department of**  
4 **Agriculture, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the Gen-**  
5 **eral Fund, the following amounts, for the following purposes:**

- 6 (1) Administrative and support  
7 services ..... \$ 3,595,824  
8 (2) Food safety ..... \$ 14,835,725  
9 (3) Natural resources ..... \$ 14,288,276  
10 (4) Market access ..... \$ 4,943,908

11 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
12 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**  
13 **1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees,**  
14 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and in-**  
15 **cluding federal funds for contract services, but excluding lottery funds**  
16 **and federal funds not described in this section, collected or received**  
17 **by the State Department of Agriculture, for the following purposes:**

- 18 (1) Administrative and support  
19 services ..... \$ 12,555,244  
20 (2) Food safety ..... \$ 32,925,272  
21 (3) Natural resources ..... \$ 24,567,864

1 (4) Market access..... \$ 20,619,770

2 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
3 **the amount of \$8,859,764 is established for the biennium beginning July**  
4 **1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery**  
5 **moneys allocated from the Parks and Natural Resources Fund to the**  
6 **State Department of Agriculture for the Oregon Plan, to be used for**  
7 **activities and projects to implement Article XV, section 4b, of the**  
8 **Oregon Constitution.**

9 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
10 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**  
11 **1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal**  
12 **funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2023 Act collected**  
13 **or received by the State Department of Agriculture, for the following**  
14 **purposes:**

- 15 (1) Administrative and support
- 16 services ..... \$ 204,723
- 17 (2) Food safety ..... \$ 2,431,874
- 18 (3) Natural resources ..... \$ 8,756,079
- 19 (4) Market access..... \$ 8,277,735

20 **“SECTION 5. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate**  
21 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**  
22 **declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect July 1, 2023.”.**

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
