**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 790**

1 On page 14 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 35 through 45 and
2 delete page 15 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 9. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the**
4 **General Fund appropriation made to the Department of Human Ser-**
5 **vices by section 1 (2), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House**
6 **Bill 5026), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, for state assess-**
7 **ments and enterprise-wide costs, is increased by \$205,644 for two posi-**
8 **tions in the Office of Training, Investigations and Safety.**

9 **“SECTION 10. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
10 **the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (8), chapter __,**
11 **Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5026), for the biennium begin-**
12 **ning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from**
13 **fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and**
14 **Medicare receipts and including federal funds for indirect cost recov-**
15 **ery, Social Security Supplemental Security Income recoveries and the**
16 **Child Care and Development Fund, but excluding lottery funds and**
17 **federal funds not described in section 2 (8), chapter __, Oregon Laws**
18 **2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5026), collected or received by the Department**
19 **of Human Services for shared services is increased by \$339,279 for two**
20 **positions in the Office of Training, Investigations and Safety.**

21 **“SECTION 11. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**

1 and the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (2), chapter
2 ___, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5026), for the biennium
3 beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses
4 from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Re-
5 cepts, and Medicare receipts and including federal funds for indirect
6 cost recovery, Social Security Supplemental Security Income recov-
7 eries and the Child Care and Development Fund, but excluding lottery
8 funds and federal funds not described in section 2 (2), chapter ___,
9 Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5026), collected or received by
10 the Department of Human Services for state assessments and
11 enterprise-wide costs is increased by \$2,615 for two positions in the
12 Office of Training, Investigations and Safety.

13 **“SECTION 12.** Section 8 of this 2023 Act is repealed on June 30, 2028.

14 **“SECTION 13.** (1) Section 2 of this 2023 Act and the amendments to
15 ORS 419B.005 by sections 3 and 4 of this 2023 Act apply to incidents
16 occurring on or after July 1, 2023.

17 **“(2)** The amendments to ORS 419B.005 by sections 5 and 6 of this
18 2023 Act apply to incidents occurring on or after July 1, 2028.

19 **“(3)** The quarterly report described in the amendments to ORS
20 419B.019 by section 7 of this 2023 Act, is first due on January 1, 2024.

21 **“SECTION 14.** The amendments to ORS 419B.005 by sections 5 and
22 6 of this 2023 Act become operative on July 1, 2028.

23 **“SECTION 15.** This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate
24 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
25 declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect on its passage.”.

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
