Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, 9 the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (9), chapter 10 \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5026), for the biennium 11 beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses 12 from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts 13 and Medicare receipts and including federal funds for indirect cost 14 recovery, Social Security Supplemental Security Income recoveries 15 and the Child Care and Development Fund, but excluding lottery funds 16 and federal funds not described in section 2 (9), chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon 17 Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5026), collected or received by the De-18 partment of Human Services, for the Oregon Eligibility Partnership, 19 is increased by \$1,830,240, for information technology system changes 20 required to carry out the provisions of this 2023 Act. 21

"SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, 1 the limitation on expenditures established by section 3 (8), chapter  $\mathbf{2}$ \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5026), for the biennium 3 beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses 4 from federal funds, excluding federal funds described in section 2,  $\mathbf{5}$ chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5026), collected 6 or received by the Department of Human Services, for the Oregon El-7 igibility Partnership, is increased by \$313,406, for information technol-8 ogy system changes required to carry out the provisions of this 2023 9 Act. 10

"SECTION 7. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$7,843, to support position costs related to system updates required to carry out the provisions of this 2023 Act.
