Here in the West King City area, the UGB was expanded along with expansions in West Tigard and South Beaverton along Roy Rogers Road. Sherwood is also looking to expand the UGB. King City and Tigard expansions alone will add 11,000 new homes in a small geographic area and not sure how many Beaverton is adding. The future of this small area will be characterized by GRIDLOCK and environmental concerns are being ignored as a collector road is being planned across a nature preserve by threat of condemnation. This is what's happening WITH planning and supposed analysis of housing needs in the Metro area. I can't imagine what would happen with unchecked expansion.
