## Re: HB 2160

Dear Chairwoman Grayber:

I am writing regarding HB 2160, an Act that amends abandonment presumptions for securities and distributions. I respresented the securities industry as an Observer to the Uniform Law Commission's drafting committee when the Revised Uniform Unclaimed Property Act ("RUUPA") was adopted. Therefore, I was eager to see if HB 2160 adopted the measures of the RUUPA that protect owners. Upon first review of the proposed legislation, it appears that there may be some areas where the bill language can be adjusted to better protect Oregon securities owners, which is of course one of the mandates of all unclaimed property statutes.

To that end, I wanted to bring to your attention some stakeholders who are experts in their respective fields and may be able to assist in strengthening the bill's protections. These organizations also participated in the drafting of the RUUPA and have tremendous experience working with the states and federal government on legislation impacting the securities industry, which is integral in protecting the savings of all citizens.
