Then, of course, when opening was fully allowed, retention of staff became paramount and our labor cost skyrocketed.

The current situation reminds of the patient that takes only one of a daily dosage of two pills. You will survive but not become healthy.

I know the Museum is not alone in the post pandemic era in the struggle to survive and to provide a quality experience and education to its visitors. It is for these reasons that I heartily support HB 2459 and ask that it receive wholehearted support from the legislature.
