The district gave an extremely late notice terminating the lease on a school facility we rent from the district. They are displacing over 400 students so they can move their administrative offices.

We have identified and begun negotiations on a new facility for our students which is located 1,000 feet outside of the GBSD. There are no other options available within the district.

Please do not pass this bill and further prohibit what are often dismal education opportunities for Oregonians and future taxpayers (our children).
