HB 2572 is an Unconstitutional bill. It violates free speech, free assembly, the right to bear arms, and the right to form a militia. In addition it creates unreasonably search and seizure at the discretion of the Attorney General if they "believe" that someone might commit an act. Reasonable cause is referenced but not required if the AG has a belief. It is very concerning that we can be held for crimes we have not committed simply if a single person believes it might have happened.

US Constitution Amendment I

Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances.

Amendment II

A well regulated Militia, being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people to keep and bear Arms, shall not be infringed.

Amendment IV

The right of the people to be secure in their persons, houses, papers, and effects, against unreasonable searches and seizures, shall not be violated, and no Warrants shall issue, but upon probable cause, supported by Oath or affirmation, and particularly describing the place to be searched, and the persons or things to be seized.
