I am writing in support of HB 2457. It ensures that our dedicated support staff get the wages they deserve, by moving DSP wages to 150% of the minimum wage and covering the PLO payroll expense. DSP wages rose significantly after you agreed to fund the current rate model during the last session. Thank you for this investment. We would not have made it through the pandemic without it, and we need to protect and enhance that investment moving forward. We are consistently paying wages that are above the amount funded in order to keep up with the upward pressure on wages we have seen in the last couple of years. This complicated and critically important work often competes with fast food when it comes to wages.
