Pearl Buck is currently serving approximately 50% fewer IDD clients today vs. the time prior to the Pandemic. The reduction in clients being served is not a demand problem because the need to support families with love ones born with IDD hasn't decreased. It's a supply problem. We can't supply enough DSP's because we can't recruit and retain DSP's given current wages.
