Re: Support for SB 530 - Natural Climate Solutions

Chair Golden and Committee Members,

JSWCD serves Jackson County by protecting our natural resources through education and technical assistance to implement voluntary conservation in partnership with private landowners and federal, state, and nonprofit partners.

JSWCD supports SB 530 which takes several positive actions to advance climate solutions in natural and working lands. Establishing state policy to move in this direction is fundamentally important, and the policies established by the bill are strong and inclusive of what needs to be done. The bill furthers the policies by establishing a Natural and Working Lands Fund and by setting in motion the establishment of baseline conditions and metrics so that we can monitor progress as we move forward.
