We already had a problem with over 500 people our voter rolls this last election when people who were now old enough to vote were not added in by the Secretary of State and the DMV at the proper time. Some counties allowed them to vote and some followed the deadlines for the voter registration when the ballots where challenged. It muddied the voter rolls.

The people should be in charge of their own voter registration.
