Thank you for the opportunity to submit written testimony of SB 530: the Natural Climate Solutions Bill. My name is Julia Weinand and I am writing in support of SB 530.

I recently graduated from the University of Portland where I studied environmental science. Because of my studies and my strong belief in climate justice, I see great value in the incentives that would be created by SB 530.

Natural climate solutions are just that – natural. Their implementation is logical as natural climate solutions both sequester the atmospheric carbon that is causing climate change, as well as increase local resilience to climate disasters.
