Had insurance not helped in covering my son's hearing aids, ear molds, audiology appts, ENT visits, etc, we wouldn't have been able to afford covering these services and devices on our own. My son would have gone without or there would have been a significant delay in getting him what he needed and that would only put him behind in his learning and living his life. When children are denied essential services at the time they are needed, you truly spend a lifetime catching up. You ultimately pay more in the long run implementing services to "fix" the things that had they been addressed early, wouldn't need fixing. Please pass this bill to allow families to support their children and not have to choose between survival and thriving.
