Dear Chair Gelser Blouin, Vice-Chair Robinson, and Members of the Committee,

I am writing on behalf of Yamhill Community Care (YCCO) in support of SB 610. YCCO is a coordinated care organization serving more than 35,000 Oregon Health Plan members in Yamhill County and parts of Washington and Polk Counties.

We have seen firsthand that food is directly linked to health care. Without healthy, accessible food options, Oregonians cannot achieve their full health potential.

Oregon has led the nation in providing Medicaid-like health coverage to undocumented children and adults. However, our work is not complete until we can ensure access to healthy food and other social determinants of health for all our communities.
