Oregon's Farmers and Ranchers produce more than 230 types of agriculture products every year. Oregon agriculture is a \$5.5 billion industry, second only to tech. Oregon Agriculture offers women more opportunities than Core High Tech. According to the 2020 Census, Oregon agriculture has **MORE women producers** and a **HIGHER percentage of women producers (44%)** than women employed in core high tech (30%).
