- It will help train people to provide better customer service and not put so many obstacles in the way of obtaining food assistance.

As a mother of three children and part of this community for 20 years, I am sure that this is one of the best proposals that the state of Oregon has had since all children deserve to have healthy food on their tables and not worry if they will eat tomorrow. They deserve to focus only on their education and as a mom, my mental health is very important to me to give them a better life, security, and education to my children. The stress of thinking about whether we will be able to have food for our children leads us to a mental state, which can end with serious depression.

And it will also support the most vulnerable community that currently does not have support because of their immigration status. I have neighbors and family that live in this hard situation.
