All those opposed to this bill should take a "Team Oregon" motorcycle endorsement course. If they did they would learn that the most important aspect to motorcycle safety is VISIBILITY. Viability can be improved by the choice of clothing a rider wears, but the fact is that motorists are not looking for riders. It is proven that the ability to lane split reduces the odds of a motorist rear ending a motorcyclist.
