I am concerned that Oregon does not currently regulate air emissions from large CAFOs and one of the proposals is for 4.6 million birds less than a mile from a school. The state also does not limit that amount of groundwater that these operations can use, even when a facility is being proposed in a groundwater management area that is known to have a limited quantity of ground water.

It is only prudent that a pause on the permitting of new and expanding CAFOs be put in place until we can adequately study and address the impacts that these operations will have on our state.
