I am blessed to live in such a pristine area of Oregon and hope to preserve its beauty, and how we use the natural resources. I support the farmers and their efforts to help manage the resources we have in this beautiful part of Oregon.

I support SB 85-1. I support long-term food production in Oregon. For this, we need to protect our farm resources from untestricted exploitation on massive scale by the poultry industry.
