The Gospel:

Matthew 6: 25-33

(translated from the Greek by E. V. Rieu)

'I bid you therefore not to fret about your lives, and what to eat and drink; nor about your bodies, and what to put on them. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing? Look at the birds of the sky. They neither sow nor reap, nor bring the harvest into barns; and yet your Heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of greater consequence than they?

'Can any one of you by fretting add a moment to his years? Then why be troubled about clothes? Learn from the lilies of the fields and how they grow. They do no work, they do not spin. But I tell you that not even Solomon in all his glory was robed like one of these. And if God so clothes the grass of the fields, which is there today and thrown into the oven to-morrow, will he not all the more clothe you, slow though you are to trust him?

'Then do not fret and say, "What are we going to eat or drink?" or "What will there be for us to wear?" - things that the pagan world pursues - for your Heavenly Father knows that all these things are your necessities. No; pursue the Kingdom and God's goodness first, and these things too will all be yours.
