In 1989, the Legislature declared, in part, "...it is the policy of this state to ensure adequate agricultural labor accommodations commensurate with the housing needs of Oregon's workers that meet decent health, safety, and welfare standards."

The Agricultural Workforce Housing Tax Credit (AWHTC) supports the construction, rehabilitation, and acquisition of housing for agricultural workers and their immediate families.

For more than 30 years, the Oregon State Legislature has invested and renewed the AWHTC. This tax credit continues to be a crucial resource for the development of safe and affordable housing for Oregon's agricultural workforce.

The tax credits in HB 2078 are not only a public commitment to provide clean, safe, and affordable housing for Oregon's agricultural workforce, but also a safeguard. The utilization of the credit ensures the housing units are registered and inspected to meet all occupational safety and health laws, rules, regulations, and standards.

Our members want to provide attractive and comfortable housing for their employees and extending this tax credit, is a signal of support for those efforts.

Oregon's farms and ranches have weathered inflation, workforce shortages, and recent legislation mandating additional burden on employers. The passage of HB 2078 and the AWHTC would maintain a proven and effective tool in Oregon's agricultural economic success.
