Oregon's elections are flawed and gamed currently as the rules apply. Voting machines and Mail-In voting are the core issues with National and Oregon voting integrity. Adding the CRV method of voting only increases the level of gaming election laws. Enhancing the current rules overseen by the Sec of States office should enforce 1) Vote in person, with a verified valid ID and voter registration on the day of elections, and to which the count be completed and announced no later than 24 hours after the end of day. 2) Mail-Ins excepted no earlier than a week in advance from voters who are legally and physically impaired or absent due to military service OR to eliminate Voter mail-in option.
