HB 2005 Support

My name is Diane Grazer, a volunteer with Moms Demand Action for Gun Sense in America. I am a resident of Washington County and a former registered nurse. I am also a grandparent to two children in the Beaverton schools, and one of my daughters is a teacher in the Hillsboro district.

I am urging you to support HB 2005, which would prohibit ghost guns and untraceable firearms. I am alarmed to learn that ghost guns are the fastest growing gun safety problem facing our country. In less than one hour, these weapons can become fully functional and are untraceable. They are becoming a weapon of choice for violent criminals and gun traffickers.

It makes sense that supporting this bill would save lives by eliminating these undetectable, untraceable firearms, which never go through a background check.

In addition to HB 2005 on the prohibition of untraceable firearms, I urge you to support HB 2006, to raise the minimum age for purchase and possession of assault weapons, and HB 2007, banning concealed carry access to city and county public buildings.
