The commitment, teamwork, responsiveness and cooperation Do it Best received from Business Oregon and the Woodburn Enterprise Zone was critical in our decision to maintain our existing northwest US distribution facility in Woodburn, Oregon, and undertake a 170,000 square foot expansion which not only will solidify Do it Best's regional growth from the State of Oregon but maintain and look to grow our local Woodburn workforce of approximately 125 team members in the years to come.

We understand the need to always conduct a cost benefit analysis as to economic development dollars spent by Oregon's taxpayers. Our ability to be awarded funding from the Strategic Reserve Fund and the local benefits from the Woodburn Enterprise Zone will be funding well spent.
