Nicotine does not cause cancer as many of the "experts" kept suggesting during their time. Obviously an effort to conflate the danger of cigarettes with vaping.

But studies so far show that e-cigarettes are far less harmful than smoking. Most of the toxic chemicals in cigarettes are not present in e-cigarettes.

Some potentially dangerous chemicals have been found in e-cigarettes. But levels are usually low and generally far lower than in tobacco cigarettes. Exposure may be the same as people who use nicotine replacement therapy (NRT) such as patches or gum.

There is no evidence that vaping causes cancer.

Don't destroy an industry that is saving lives.
