University Health Services currently offers testing and treatment for sexually transmitted infections, testing and pre-exposure prophylaxis for HIV, education and prescription for all available non-surgical contraception options, access to free safer sex supplies, access to emergency contraception, pregnancy testing, and pregnancy options counseling and referrals.

We support HB 2002 and stand ready to add additional services as outlined in the bill, provided we can attain the resources to do so safely and following evidence-based guidelines.

The University of Oregon University Health Services believes our students have the right to access comprehensive medical care and UHS strongly supports the omnibus bill HB 2002. We urge you to pass this bill.
