Reviving an industrial commercial roaster was a serious challenge to begin with, but the supply chain disruptions and lack of demand that resulted from the pandemic lasted years and made it even more difficult. We received considerable assistance from both the SBDC and Business Oregon, and I can honestly say we wouldn't have made it without the grants we received from Business Oregon in 2022. Furthermore, various resources within the Business Oregon network were essential in helping out with questions concerning financing, export regulations and documentation, succession planning, and trade show assistance to name a few. Sales have started to pick up and we are now fabricating and assembling our increasing number of roasters at AAA Metal Fabrication in Beaverton.
