I am writing in support of SB 525-1, that reads in part "a Person may not use, cause the person's employee to use or cause to be used on property owned or controlled by the person a gasoline-powered leaf blower within the urban growth boundary of a city with a population of 75,000 or greater."

Gas Powered Leaf Blowers (GPLB) are hazardous to the health of the individuals who use them, in terms of noise as well as pollutants produced from those leaf blowers that they breathe. Further, it disproportionally harms workers at these typically small landscape businesses.
