I have a huge volume of patients needing my skill set as an oculoplastic surgeon, but my main problem is a critical staffing shortage, both in my clinic as well as at the surgery center here in Ashland. We have been experiencing extreme difficulty finding and hiring certified scrub techs for the surgery center. An apprenticeship program would greatly alleviate this problem.
