Though progress has been made, there are still multiple barriers to offering educational opportunities in our prisons. We are behind most other states in these areas. We need the support of the Oregon Legislature, HECC and DOC to expand access to education in DOC facilities.

We are all aware that there are so many challenges for people returning to our communities from prison. We know that formerly incarcerated students are more likely to succeed with additional support on campus. Let's give them that support. And surely our professional licensure boards are capable of evaluating each applicant on their merits.

We must pass these bills in order to make success achievable for people post-incarceration and to make our communities safer.
