When will the infringement on the rights of the Property Owner end? Answer, lets start with the rejection of Measure SB611. Show the Property Owners in Oregon there is equal and equitable representation for all the people, not just 'special interest groups'.

This Measure will have a reverse effect on the Tenants, it will cause Property Ownership to increase the rent, demand stricter application requirements and increase pre-rental deposits. The cost impact will be substantial and is in direct response to Measure SB611. Unlike the Government the Landlord/Property Owners has to pay their creditors and does not have an unlimited budget.
