To the Senate Committee on Judiciary,

I am writing you to urge you to oppose SB 348. This is specifically in regards to the proposed amendment. Stuffing a placeholder bill with all of the language from a measure that was found unconstitutional is wrong and downright hateful towards one specific group. The measure passed by 0.7%, was funded solely by out-of-state billionaires and included incorrect and (most likely intentionally) misleading language in the official ballot summary.

Changing the age to own any firearm from 18 to 21 is clear age discrimination. Criminalizing past purchases of magazines when it is currently legal to buy them is federally illegal and just downright immoral. Raising the initial permit price by almost 3 times and raising the renewal cost by more than 2 times is predictable and hateful towards Oregonians who are less wealthy. The Harney County Judge was correct when he said that this bill "was designed to keep poor Oregonians from owning firearms." The Senate is currently trying to continue this discrimination against Oregonians who are less wealthy.

The amendment was written by someone who is hateful towards anyone who thinks differently than he does. It was written out of pure hate for gun owners in Oregon. Please stop SEB 348 from moving forward.
