I'm writing to express not just an opinion against SB 348, but complete disdain for it and questioning the competency of State Sen. Floyd Prozanski. It is true there is some reasonable protection for elected officials as they seek to implement laws, but they are under oath to propose laws, to the best of their ability, that fit within the bounds of the US Constitution and Bill of Rights, which includes boundaries as interpreted by the Supreme Court. When a Senator knowingly waists tax payer dollars submitting bills with components that have already been struck down on a national level, especially with such a high profile topic, that individual is showing they are not attempting to adhere to their oath and needs to be held accountable. These bills waist millions on both sides and actually reflect an unconstitutional tax in that the government has an unending coffer and those who oppose have limited funds in comparison.

SB348 is unconstitutional in that it requires a permit to purchase, limits magazine capacity as 30 round magazines have been deemed accessable and common for many years, the added taxation via permitting causes financial limitation as it inhibits socioeconomically, permits could be limited based on "squishy" terms that are too open to interpretation, gun ownership limited to 21+, and a defacto gun owner registration through the permitting process.
